

# NUIM India Scholarship Programme 2012 - Deadline for Applications Extended

**Deadline for applications extended to June 10, 2012**

The National University of Ireland Maynooth is proud to announce its new range of scholarships for Indian postgraduates for those starting their courses in September 2012.

**Three 50% tuition fee scholarships** are being offered for Indian applicants to Taught Masters courses, one in each of these subject areas:

**A further fund of €50,000** will provide additional scholarships of between €1,000 and €5,000 for one year to applicants based on merit. All taught Masters courses are eligible for these awards.

The Director of International Education at NUIM will be in India from 23<sup>rd</sup> May until 8<sup>th</sup> June visiting NUIM's trusted agents and will make on-the-spot offers for programmes in Business, Economics, Finance & Accounting programmes. ## **How to Apply**

To be considered for these scholarships, applicants must have submitted a full application for admission by **June 10, 2012**. A separate scholarship application is not required. Applicants can apply to NUIM free of charge through one of our trusted education agents in India, or directly through PAC (an application fee applies). Candidates must be Indian nationals and resident in India and subject to overseas tuition fees. Awards will be based on previous academic ability and performance. Decisions will be made by a panel and announced on or before 1 July 2012. All decisions are final.
